- Bus fundraiser request Ms. Meagan Moulton
  - Heavy use of buses by Outdoor ed, physical education and sport groups - Currently have 2 - 60 seater buses
  - Oldest 2008 and 2015. The older bus is starting to have increase cost for repairs.
  - 97% students are using off campus events = the need for transportation.
  - Used not only for the above groups but also for bands and feeder school class activities.
  - 40 seater bus and looking for funding in addition to the fundraising that will be done at the school to share the cost. (le. cheque writing campaign)
  - Southland charges \$250/trip. Not financially feasible based on the number of activities
  - Question from David is there a dedicated bus fund. Principal Wilson will look into setting up an online platform to create a donation campaign.

- Question; Resource Room available to all students? We do try to limit it; as it is available to help specific students with their learning needs. Those student who do not need additional learning support are encouraged to use learning commons or cafeteria
- Question: Guidelines around the use of AI. It is being developed and Principal will look into it the status of the guidelines and will share with meeting notes.
- Question about the Oct. 6 pending teacher strike discussion around what will happen to activities outside school hours.
- Question: An electronic sign for the school. Principal is still working with the city to figure it out. Principal asking parents to reach out to the local

city councillor about the issue to help expedite the need.

Joan shared information for feedback and will be starting to share on the weekly. We have a highly engaged community where there is a lot of parents who are also Alum. The idea is hosting a Speed Mentoring activity as part of the Flex Day in March 2026. The idea is to connect EMHS alum or interested parents to come to school during this Flex day and offer 'speed mentoring'. Joan will send out a survey to find out interest and what career, trades, professional services that they could speak too and their availability on March 19 to host an activity with student. It is a low commitment to the mentor as you don't have to present anything - its about connections with the real world. Last year they piloted this format with an engineering firm and it was well received by the students. Joan's ask - is to share with your networks and/or offer any feedback to Joan about this idea.
