## - Alberta Education Assurance Measure Results - Spring 24

- Increase 3 year and 5 year completion rate
- Want to improve the 5 year completion rate overall to 97% and 95% for 3 year
- Decrease in access to support and services to 81.8% Down 4%
- Increase of 1% in parent involvement
- 100% completion rate for our Aboriginal student body Diploma results
- 100% who wrote the diploma in Chem, SS, ELA achieved acceptable grade
- 20% higher than the provincial average
