Nov/Dec in Review

  - Strength training (new) - currently operating as a club. New opportunity for students offered by teachers
- PE Winter Hostel Trip - Dec. 10/11th
- Drama Directors Night - Dec. 10th - students have to create their own plays. Presented 5 play and had 50 people in attendance.

## 6. ASCE grant review and proposals

- Sabrina asked Joan to provide some feedback on the the use of the lending library and if this was a good use of funds.
- Joan provided feedback that when people are in the office, they do review the books but not many people are signing out the books.
- Joan suggested that she could highlight some of the books within the weekly email communication, work with the broadcast students to highlight and promote to students to bring home for parents
- Cathy provided feedback that parents are not typically in the building; so access to library might be low because there is little or no traffic. Might be good to actively promote it in the weekly rundowns or post on the Facebook page. Suggested using the funds to book a presenter on a topic that would be of interest to the parent community.
- Sabrina will ask Cindy to post about the library on the school Facebook page.

## 7. Questions

Question asked about posts on social media community group about the cancellation of academic awards for all students, all grades and all academics. Feedback she gave was that it was a wonderful awards night for the community focused on the academic achievements of the students. She wondered the continuation of night for Griffins and sports - which is deserving - but feel that the cancellation of the recognition night is the wrong choice. Would really like to see the night come back especially as the school is so academically.

Discussion around the fact that the recognition awards were not necessarily cancelled but rather shifted to types of recognition that would recognize students

inclusively; about finding the right balance for all students - those who are academically excelling but also for those who should be recognized because of their resilience. Open to continue to having those conversations and have a further discussion about what a balance recognition approach would be.

Comment from the parents is that they would love the return of academic and arts recognition awards night.

Question asked about the potential cancellation of the Halifax band trip. Has the impression that teachers don't want to go on the trip because of the strike; looking for clarification.

CBE organize these opportunities that are led by teacher in charge and are required to meet a number of criteria in order for it to go forward with these trips so if there are changes it may be due to some barriers with that teacher in charge and would recommend following up to the teacher to find out all the information.
