6. Principal Report: Mike Wilson

Two funding proposals

- a. Scrum Machine This is a funding request for a rugby scrum machine. A rugby scrum machine is a training device used to help rugby players practice scrummaging techniques. It typically consists of a heavy metal frame with padded sections where players engage to simulate the resistance of an opposing scrum. Some machines are weighted or spring-loaded to mimic real match conditions, helping players develop strength, technique, and coordination in a controlled environment. The plan is to use the machine to facilitate safe contact drills for the rugby teams and football teams. Cost of the machine will be \$9500. This funding would support approx. 150 students. One-time request
- b. Math Portable White Wall Teaching Resource a one-time purchase adhesive whiteboard rolls for the classroom walls. The teacher mobile podium also the teachers and students access to writing with an iPad without the need to carry it around. Allows teacher/students can work collaboratively. 50x4ft in size. The school currently owns 6 of them. Lifetime of the product is three years. Funding for 8 rolls @ \$8572.96+GST and 10 Bontec Tilting lecterns & Podium mobile stand for \$1999.90+GST
